For the half-year ended 31 December 2001, the principal assets of the business comprised the aircraft fleet, all (except one) of which were registered and domiciled in Australia. These assets are used flexibly across the route network. Accordingly there is no suitable basis of allocating such assets and the related liabilities between geographic areas.

Independent review report to the members of Qantas Airways Limited

Scope

We have reviewed the financial report of Qantas Airways Limited for the half-year ended 31 December 2001 in the form of the Rule 4.13(b) version of Appendix 4B of the Australian Stock Exchange Listing Rules, consisting of the statement of financial performance, statement of financial position, statement of cash flows, accompanying notes and the directors' declaration set out on pages 3 to 21. The financial report includes the consolidated financial statements of the consolidated entity, comprising the Company and the entities it controlled at the end of the half-year or from time to time during the half-year. The Company's directors are responsible for the financial report.

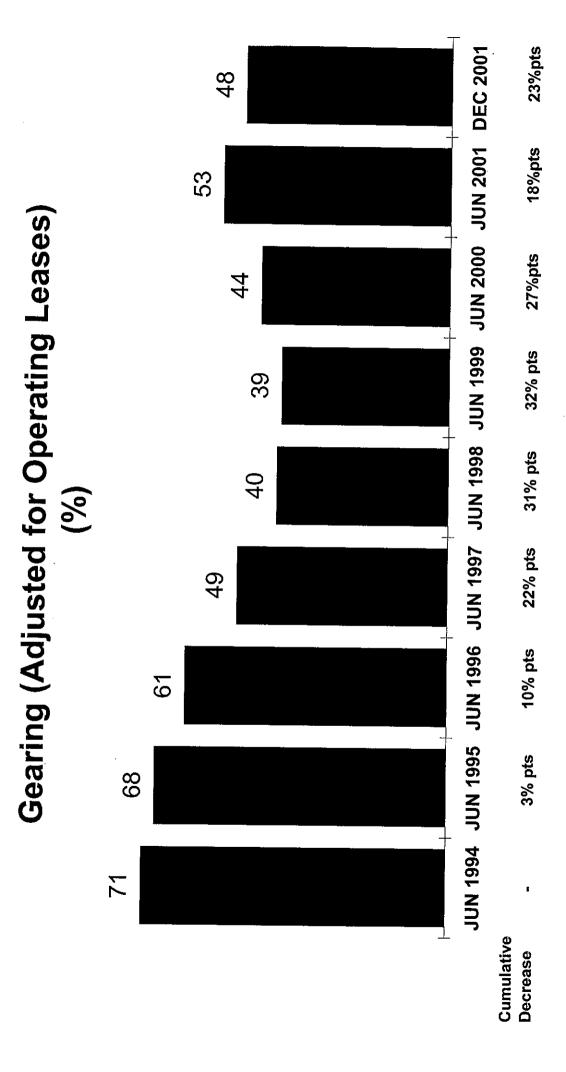

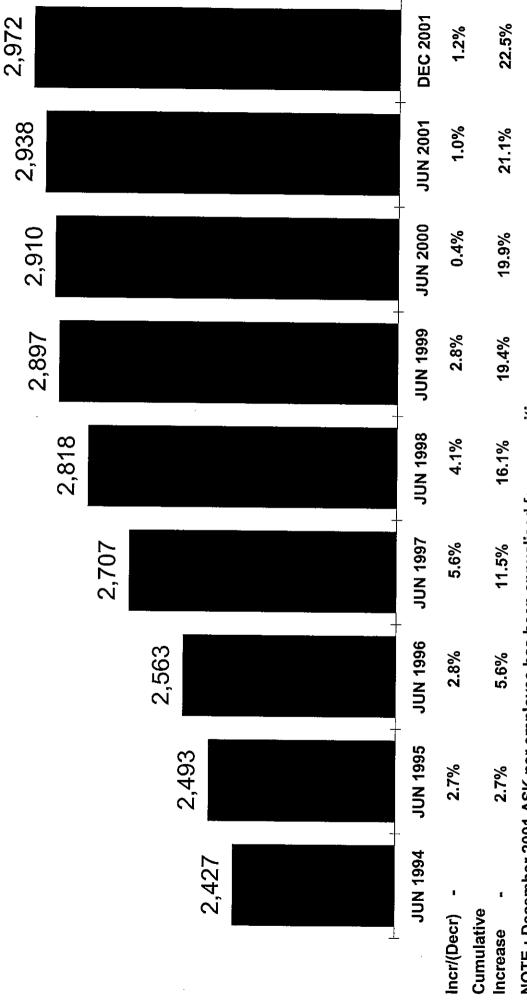
