PRELIMINARY MONTHLY TRAFFIC AND CAPACITY STATISTICS AUGUST 2005

Summary of Traffic and Capacity Statistics

Month of August 2005

Total Domestic (Qantas, QantasLink and Jetstar) traffic, measured in Revenue Passenger Kilometres (RPKs) increased by 4.1 per cent in August 2005 while capacity, measured in Available Seat Kilometres (ASKs) increased by 6.2 per cent. This resulted in a revenue seat factor of 77.1 per cent, 1.5 percentage points lower than for August 2004.

Total International (Qantas and Australian Airlines) RPKs increased by 4.3 per cent in August, while ASKs increased by 1.0 per cent over the same period. The resulting revenue seat factor of 74.3 per cent was 2.3 percentage points higher than the previous year.

August Group (comprising Qantas Domestic, QantasLink, Jetstar, Qantas International and Australian Airlines) passenger numbers increased by 2.3 per cent over the previous year. RPKs increased by 4.2 per cent, while ASKs were up 2.7 per cent, resulting in a revenue seat factor of 75.2 per cent, which was 1.1 percentage points higher than the previous year.

Financial Year to Date August 2005

Total Domestic revenue seat factor for the financial year to August 2005 decreased by 1.8 percentage points to 78.1 per cent when compared with year to date August 2004, while total Domestic yield excluding exchange increased by 3.2 per cent over the same period. Total International yield excluding exchange for the financial year to August increased by 3.1 per cent when compared with the same period last year. Total International revenue seat factor increased by 1.5 percentage points to 76.7 per cent over the same period.

Group passenger numbers for the year to August 2005 increased by 3.4 per cent from the previous year. RPKs increased by 3.9 per cent, while ASKs increased by 3.3 per cent, resulting in a revenue seat factor of 77.1 per cent, 0.4 percentage points higher than the previous year.

Recent Developments

The 2005 Annual General Meeting of Qantas Airways Limited will be held at 2.00pm on Thursday, 13 October 2005 in the Ballroom of the Hyatt Hotel, Canberra. Shareholders who are unable to attend will be able to hear a live webcast of the Annual General Meeting on the Qantas website.

On 21 September 2005, Qantas said that it supported the new security measures, announced by the Prime Minister, for Australia's airports. Qantas said the new measures are consistent with its submission to the Wheeler review of security and policing at Australia's airports. Qantas also said given the considerable security costs already borne by airlines - and particularly Qantas in Australia - it doesn't believe the funding of additional measures should be another impost on the industry. Qantas therefore supports Sir John Wheeler's recommendation that Government fund the provision of general policing and the CTFR function at Australia's 11 major airports.
